Services Offered:

1. Librarian Visit

Member(s) of our staff visit by invitation to share information, provide assistance or represent the Library.

Librarian visits can provide:

- Presentation to students, faculty or parents
- Provide handouts for families that highlight specific events such as the Summer Reading Challenge.

2. Event Attendance

Our Outreach Team attends community events to share information, raise the library's profile, and promote the library in the community. We are happy to set up a booth, speak with the attendees, or participate in a partner-led activity.

Request a visit:

1. Requirements:

- Events, schools, community groups, or organizations must be based in or working in our service area, the Branson and Hollister school districts.
- Library Center of the Ozarks must be allowed to attend the event without fees.
- We book on a first come, first served basis, but will do our best to accommodate as many groups or events as we can.
- We request at least thirty (30) days' notice of your event.
